On Papermache, we have a special opportunity to interact with our peers and full text PDFs, protected by intellectual property licenses. For this to work, we need authors and their insights to be cited in the desired style formats before adaptively reusing the content in new work.

Previously, this required thick paper style manuals that updated syntax yearly by conference as well as deep wisdom of how an appropriate style was supposed to look considering the source. Today, you have copy and paste. Try it right now on this document: highlight this text section, right click and you'll see three options. Click Cite and select your preferred style. Those citations? Immaculately formatted the first time along with the highlighted passage that together are ready to transform your work and make you look smart!

You can also leave a comment on the highlighted sections of a PDF so others can reply, and up or downvote your comment. Expect discussion threads as interesting as the paper itself, as peers consume the original work and give it a life after grading. Go ahead, give it a try and leave a comment here.

Sharing is also done by highlighting. Highlight an extra special passage, click Share, and select a social network. URLs and passages are pre-copied so you can paste them anywhere. Be aware that Paper links will abide by an author's privacy preferences, so original documents might not be available to members of the public.

There are a bunch of features in the hopper but now the site is at its most pure. So it's your turn. Play around this this so when you find a paper in the future, you'll be ready to rock.
